Crating Areas

Standard commercial canopy tents may be available for rent in 5' x 10' or 10' x 10' sizes. If available, an order form will be published on USDAAtitlemania.com in May.

Personal shade canopies may be set up in designated areas on the field for day crating. Overnight crating or camping is not permitted on the grounds.

Some parking is available on the perimeter of the show grounds. Should entries exceed capacity, additional parking is across the street from the field. Should you wish to crate your dog in your vehicle, you must exercise good judgment and do so at your own risk.

There will be no electricity available in the kenneling area.

Entries & Acceptance

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Checks & Credit Cards Accepted

Entry fees may be satisfied with either a check payable to USDAA or submission of the credit card form in this test schedule.

Please ensure the credit card form is legibly completed and included with your entry form for valid entry.

Special Eligibility for Competing at a Higher Level

Special eligibility rules allow competitor to enter the event at a level of their choice that is equal to or higher than otherwise stipulated in USDAA Rules & Regulations for tiling purposes. This allows competitors to compete at a level that they believe is commensurate with their abilities without regard to past experience in competition in dog agility.

A competitor entering the "higher level" under these special eligibility rules must compete in all three rounds of a Class Type at the same level in order to be eligible for Class Type awards.

When a competitor competes at a level higher than they would otherwise be eligible under USDAA Rules & Regulations, qualifications earned are recorded and will count towards regulation USDAA titles by either:

- subsequently completing the lower level qualification requirements to establish eligibility pursuant to USDAA Rules & Regulations, or
- qualifying in all three rounds of a class type at this event, in which case a competitor shall be awarded a title at the entered level and need not complete lower level qualification requirements for title. In this case, the competitor must file a written request for title in lieu of satisfying the lower level eligibility requirements no later than ten (10) days following the event.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration status or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

Advance Request for Measurement Verification

When not entering an event electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In FEO Not Allowed

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may

- Run the dog at the higher height in the same program based upon the measurement,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Performance Program,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Veterans Program if the dog is 8 years old

Dogs may NOT run For Exhibition Only (FEO) at this event.

Because entry into a higher height is permitted in the Performance and Championship Programs, a dog measuring lower may not be moved to a lower height in either program.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, children, and guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Bitches In Season Allowed

Special provisions are being made for competitors who have bitches in season (BIS). Any dog that is ill or exhausted and pregnant bitches cannot take part in the running of a class at competition. Our policies for this event are:

- A protective ground mat for the BIS to sit upon at the start of the run MUST BE USED at the start line in every ring.
- Each competitor must provide a mat for every run.
- Outside the ring, BIS's shall wear sanitary britches at all times when moving about the grounds at the event.
- Handlers are required to notify the trial secretary as soon as they know they will be running a BIS at the event.
- Handlers shall minimize the exposure of their BIS's to other dogs, and limit their movement about the show grounds.
- BIS shall be noted next to their name on the gate sheet for every class so that other competitors and ring crew are aware.
- BIS shall run in their assigned position in the running order.

Fix & Continue Will Be Allowed At This Event

The [USDAA Policy Statement on Training in the Ring or "Fix & Continue"](http://usdaa.com/binary/files/20180828FixandContinuePolicy.pdf) has been adopted for this event and is hereby incorporated in its entirety by reference. Competitors are expected to familiarize themselves with this policy, which can be found on the USDAA web site at <http://usdaa.com/binary/files/20180828FixandContinuePolicy.pdf>

Fix & Continue during a competition run generally provides for repeat of an obstacle at handler's discretion under conditions set forth in the Policy Statement. When discretion is exercised to utilize the Fix & Continue, their score will be recorded as an elimination and the maximum course time set to 60 seconds. This practice may be utilized only once in any Standard, Jumpers, or Relay class (including similarly-styled tournament classes at qualifying events). The competitor must continue working the course in flow, while "fixing" and "continuing" on the course. See the Policy Statement referenced above for complete details.

Class Descriptions

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

Masters Challenge Classes - Championship & Performance

All dogs - regardless of level of competition - are eligible for entry in the Masters Challenge classes and to earn qualifying scores. These qualifying scores will remain on the dog's record and calculate toward Masters Challenge titles once the dog achieves the Masters Standard / Masters Performance Standard and Masters Jumpers / Masters Performance Jumpers titles.

Additionally, these dogs continue to be eligible for their appropriate level in the regular classes at all levels, unless stipulated otherwise in the Agility Test Schedule. Competitive placements in the Masters Challenge Standard and Jumpers classes accumulate points for annual ranking for Agility Top TenSM and Performance Top TenSM.

Prizes & Awards

Prizes and Awards

All-Around Versatility Championship Awards

All-Around Versatility Championship awards are to be made in each Program—Championship, Performance, and Veterans— in each height class overall without regard to level based upon the Qualification and Bonus points accumulated through all rounds. Tiebreaker points shall be awarded based upon relative placement in each class:

- Trophy & "All-Around" Championship Title for first place in each height class overall
- Gold, Silver & Bronze Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd ranked competitors overall in each height class

Competitors are advised to be present with their dogs at the specified time for awards presentations. No awards will be mailed.

Overall Class Type Awards

Class Type awards are to be made in each Program—Championship, Performance, and Veterans— overall without regard to height or level based upon the Qualification and Bonus points accumulated through all rounds. Tiebreaker points shall be awarded based upon relative placement in each class:

- Trophy awarded for first place in each Class Type overall
- Gold, Silver & Bronze Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd ranked competitors overall in each Class Type overall

Competitors are advised to be present with their dogs at the specified time for awards presentations. No awards will be mailed.

Individual Class Awards

- Qualifying rosettes will be awarded for all Qualifying Rounds at this event in all classes
- Flat placement ribbons will be provided for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for all individual classes at this event

Due to the number of classes at this event, competitors are advised to pick up their ribbons for individual classes at the awards desk. When completing a title, competitors are urged to report their success to the "brag desk" so that all can share in an announcement across the grounds. There will be no separate awards ceremony, but photos may be made at the awards stage at specified times during the event. No placement or qualification awards will be mailed.
